Steps involve:

- Register for the course
- Appoint supervisor/advisor
- Have regular discussions with supervisor
- Conduct research
- Prepare manuscript
- Register for the colloquium
- Present in colloquium
- Submit final paper to supervisor/advisor

Appointment of SV/ Advisor

- Please appoint 1 supervisor
- Kindly visit the FEP website to search for potential SV in your research area. Most of our lecturers in the Economics/ Islamic Economics research field are from the Centre for Sustainable and Inclusive Development Studies (SID) or lecturers who are teaching SE and SEI courses. https://www.ukm.my/fep/sid2/
- If you have your own title, please consult any potential supervisor who are expert in the field. You can also view the lecturer's expertise on the FEP website at https://www.ukm.my/fep/siswazah/?page_id=3418
- Fill up the supervisory form. Please submit supervisory form no later than 5th April 2024 (end of week 4, Friday).

ACADEMIC PAPER EPPE6908 & EPPE6906

- The structure and approach of scientific research must begin with a defined research question, which results in a well-designed research protocol that plans the overall approach. This foundation should lead to a set of data from which the manuscript can be constructed.
- Total words of manuscript are 6000 to 8000 words in length (single line spacing and 10 pt. size Times New Roman throughout the paper except for the headlines).
- The structures of the manuscript typically have the following components:

ACADEMIC PAPER EPPE6908 & EPPE6906

- 1. Authorship and Originality to ensure that the manuscript is original and based from actual research work performed by the student, these points need to be considered:
- Plagiarism is a serious concern and must be avoided by the author/student. The supervisor will ensure that the **similarity rate is less than 30% using Turnitin software** (the report will be attached for each submission by the supervisor). Similarity index beyond 30% will affect course grading of the student.

ACADEMIC PAPER EPPE6908 & EPPE6906

- To reduce similarity index, sentence structure need to be modified and rewritten, not copied entirely from the source.
- All source of data/work need to be properly cited and provide the reference to avoid plagiarism issue.
- Authorship and the order of authorship must be agreed upon by all of the authors (main supervisor or cosupervisors) and any other personnel who participated in the work but are not included as an author.

ACADEMIC PAPER EPPE6908 & EPPE6906

- Master of Economics students are required to <u>present</u> and <u>publish</u> one (1) article in conference proceeding for grading purposes – <u>EPPE6908 only</u>.
- Master of Islamic Economics students (EPPE6906): the writing of manuscript is ready to be published & present your progress in the FEP Colloquium.
- Article can be written in Malay or English language (based on supervisor consent).
- The writing format is as follows:-

EPPE6908 & EPPE6906 Academic Paper (Economics & Islamic Economics) use the format of *Jurnal Ekonomi Malaysia* (JEM) (Refer: https://www.ukm.my/jem/)

What if the academic paper is not complete?

- If the research is not completed within one semester, your SV will give you an "**SM**" or "**in progress**" grade.
- You are then required to register for the course again in the following semester and complete the research and all other requirements.
- Fees need to be paid.
- This is conditional upon you completing at least
 75% of work in the earlier semester.

Grading

Grade	Description
80%	To be assigned by SV based on the quality of your project research and manuscript.
20%	To be assigned by the assessor based on the presentation content, delivery and how the student answers the questions.
TL – Tidak Lengkap (Incomplete)	Will be given if manuscript is not ready (but ALMOST ready) by the end of the semester. Student may need to complete the manuscript within 2 weeks of the new semester.
SM – Sedang Maju (In progress)	As discussed in previous slide.
