UNESCO Chair in Social Practices in Intercultural Communication and Social Cohesion



On February 22nd 2019, KITA-UKM was awarded a UNESCO Chair on Social Practices in Intercultural Communication and Social Cohesion with KITA Founding Director Distinguished Prof. Datuk Dr. Shamsul Amri Baharuddin as the Chair holder. This is the very first UNESCO Chair to be awarded to UKM and the first in Malaysia within the field of intercultural communication, focusing on ethnic studies and social cohesion.

- Contribute to stopping and decreasing marginalization of ethnic minorities and creolized communities through valorization of their cultural heritage;
- Disseminate relevant knowledge on Social Cohesion through publications, academic conferences and roundtable discussion with civil society;
- Cooperate closely with UNESCO and existing UNESCO Chairs on relevant programmes and activities;
- Initiate special projects with global outreach.
