

Tuition fee: Stated on the offer letter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tuition fees exemption for exchange students from partner universities. • Students from non-partner universities should pay full tuition fees with an estimation of MYR 2,750 – MYR 6,000 per semester. 3. <p>Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL) & Single-Entry Visa (SEV)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL) is mandatory requirements for those who wish to pursue their studies in Malaysia. 2. e-VAL application is through the EMGS website at https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/. 3. Single Entry Visa (SEV) are require to selected country citizen that need to obtain from Malaysian Embassy prior to enter Malaysia after receive the e-VAL. 
<p>Health insurance</p>	<p>International students are required to obtain insurance coverage while studying in Malaysia. It is compulsory to purchase insurance from the EMGS system while applying for Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL).</p>

Arrival in UKM	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are advised to arrive in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia three (3) days before the registration date. 2. Students will require to undergo a health medical check-up at the UKM Health Centre (Bangi campus) within seven (7) days of arrival in Malaysia. 3. UKM Global will arrange for airport pickup service only on 14th March 2025 (Friday). 4. The nearest airport to UKM Bangi campus is KLIA and KLIA2 terminal.
