The UKM Doctor of Family Medicine program has emerged as a pioneer and reference centre for postgraduate programs in Malaysia since 1992. It is renowned for producing Family Medicine Specialists who cater to the diverse healthcare needs of the country. Family Medicine addresses the healthcare requirements of individuals across all age groups, encompassing various diseases and emphasises on disease prevention and long term continuous care in the community.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

HOSPITAL PHASE:

In the initial two years of the program, trainees undergo hospital clinical placements specialising in various medical fields and clinical specialties.

HOSPITAL CLINIC PHASE:

- Year 3: Internship at Klinik Primer HCTM
- Year 4: Specialist in training in Government Health Clinics

The program also entails lectures, small group discussions, and workshops which facilitate knowledge acquisition via face-to-face and online/virtual methods. Trainees also need to complete a dissertation project as part of the research requirement. Continuous assessments (formative) and a final assessment (summative) ensures a comprehensive evaluation. The program conducts theoretical and clinical examinations in three parts at the National Family Medicine Conjoint Board level.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

- Basic medical degree from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia or equivalent (M.D., M.B.B.S., M.B. Ch; recognised by the Senate); AND Certificate of Full Registration from the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC).
- At least one year of service as a fully registered Medical Officer with MMC.
- Obtain satisfactory results in the Pre-Entry examination.
- Successfully pass the admission interview.
- Provide letter of recommendation from previous employer(s).
- International Students must fulfill UKM's English Language Proficiency requirement.
