PROGRAM STRUCTURE MASTER IN MEDICAL SCIENCE

Registration is open through out the year

Duration of study: 2-6 semesters (full-time)/ 4 – 8 semesters (part time)

> Language of study: Bahasa Melayu and English

Mode of Delivery:

Conventional – programme consists of 100% research work and thesis write-up (i.e. supervision of research work and thesis writing, proposal writing, proposal presentation, progress report and presentation, self-directed learning session, manuscript preparation and submission).

Minimum requirements:

Students are required to attend a Research Methodology course (organized by the Faculty or University), publish at least ONE indexed manuscript and present a research paper in at least ONE conference.

6-12 semesters (full time)/8-14 semesters (part time)

Language of study: Bahasa Melayu and English

Mode of Delivery:

Conventional – programme consists of 100% research work and thesis write-up (i.e. supervision of research work and thesis writing, proposal writing, proposal presentation, progress report and presentation, self-directed learning session, manuscript preparation and submission).

Minimum requirements:

Students are required to attend a Research Methodology course (organized by the Faculty or University), publish at least TWO indexed manuscript and present a research paper in at least ONE conference.
