Melaka's attraction lies in its rich and colorful past. Melaka has renowned as the place where the history of Malaysia began. From a quiet fishing village back in the early 15th century, Melaka grew into one of the world's greatest trading empires. In the 16th century, Melaka gained a reputation as the foremost maritime trading centre in the region. Merchants came from as far as Arabia, China, India and Europe to conduct trade in silk, spices, gold and porcelain.

Today, there's a lot more to Melaka; in addition to its fascinating stories, legends and historical attractions. Centuries of multi-racial living cultures have produced varied customs, festivals, food and languages. Melaka is located in Peninsular Malaysia, facing the Melaka Straits and covers an area of 1,658sq.km, which divided into three districts namely Alor Gajah, Melaka Tengah and Jasin.

"Visit Historic Melaka Means Visit Malaysia", as its chosen slogan, Melaka has so much to offer and become the melting pot of all races. From its historical heritage site to cultural richness. The inception of Melaka as the Historic Cities of the Straits of Melaka, together with Georgetown, on 7th July 2008 by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has demonstrated a succession of its historical and cultural ascendancy as a trading part linking from the East to the West.



History

Melaka Tree

Melaka Tree, also known as *Phyllanthus Emlica* is a deciduous tree in the family *Phyllanthaceae*. The state of Melaka is named after this tree. Only a few trees are left and we may find some of the tree in front of Porta De Santiago.



Melaka Sultanate Palace Museum

The Melaka Sultanate Palace is a replica of a Sultan's palace during the period of the Melaka Sultanate. Apart from the unique building design and ornate wood carvings, visitors would also be able

to gain insights into the institution of the Melaka Malay Sultanate and experience a true palace atmosphere.

Porta De Santiago

A prominent landmark in Melaka which translates to 'The Famous' in Portuguese is one of the few oldest surviving remnants of European architecture in the whole of Asia. It was built by the Portuguese Admiral, Alfonso de Albuquerque during the Portuguese invasion in 1511. The fortress was built to consolidate their gains in Melaka after they defeated the armies of the Melaka Sultanate. At that time, the Portuguese



believed that Melaka would someday become a vital port which links Portugal to the spice trade from China. The fort changed hands in 1641 when the would someday become a vital port which links Portugal to the spice trade from China. The fort changed hands in 1641 when the successfully

drove Dutch the Portuguese out of Melaka. After the Dutch got their hands on the A'Famosa, they placed their company logo, the 'VOC' coat of arms about the gates of Porta De Santiago (A'Famosa). 'VOC' is the abbreviation of Verenigde Oostindische Compagnie.

Ruins of the St. Paul's Church

The St. Paul's Church was built at the summit of St. Paul's Hill in 1521 by a Catholic Portuguese Captain, Duarte Coelho. The church is the church ruins that sit on the top of the St Paul's Hill. The hill was originally named as Melaka Hill. It was then changed to Monti Ali Maria or Mary's Hill after the Portuguese took over the hill. The St Paul's Church was originally a chapel and was known to the Portuguese in Melaka



as the Chapel of Mother of God (Madre de Deus) or Our Lady of the Hill (Nossa Senhora do Oiteiro).

Stadthuys Museum Complex

The Stadthuys also known as the Red Square, is a historical structure situated in the heart of Melaka Town. It was built by the Dutch occupants in 1650 as the office of the Dutch Governor and Deputy Governor, also the oldest-surviving VOC building in Asia. The Stadthuys Museum Complex is composed by History and Ethnography Museum, Literature Museum, Admiral Cheng Ho's Gallery, The



Governor's Museum and The Museum of Government Democracy.

Proclamation of Independence Memorial

The Proclamation of Independence Memorial was set up and officiated by our first and former Prime Minister, Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra Al-Haj on 31 August 1985, exactly 38 years after our country achieve its independence. Housed in the former Malacca Club building built in 1912, this British colonial building was then used by the British upper class and the British administrator for

various social activities, before it was open to the public after the independence of Malaysia. This memorial houses invaluable exhibits of the country's struggle leading to the independence. Exhibits include relics, manuscripts, video tapes, films and slides.

Kampung Hulu Mosque



Built in 1728 by Dato' Shamsuddin, it is one of the oldest mosques in Malaysia. Its unique architectural style is not traceable to others in the country.

Christ Church

This oldest Protestant Church in Malaysia took 12 years to build by the Dutch in 1753. It has 8 feet long ceiling beams, which are cut in one piece and constructed without any joints. The handmade pews are definitely original which date 200 years back.

Flor De Lamar

The Maritime Museum was built in early 1990 and itself a replica of a Portuguese galleon, the 'Flor de La Mar'. The Maritime Museum was officially opened by the Prime Minister of Malaysia, Tun Dr. Mahathir bin Mohamad on June 13, 1994. The main theme of



the museum is about the history of seafaring in Melaka as well as the spread of the Melaka's commercial influence during the Malaya Sultanate right up to the colonization eras of Portuguese, the Dutch and the British. The exhibits include old maps, ship models, weaponry, and maritime-related accessories and artifacts. There are also dioramas and a special corner dedicated to Panglima Awang who was the first Malay seafarer voyaging around the world.

Hang Li Poh's Well

Built in 1459 under the royal command of Sultan Mansor Shah for Hang Li Poh (the Chinese princess who married the Sultan), the well never runs dry up and was the only source of water supply during great droughts. The Dutch enclosed it with stout walls in 1677 to maintain its ultimate into a wishing well and it is said that those



who throw coins into it will return to Melaka time and again.

Villa Sentosa



One of the houses in Kampung Morten which has been converted into a private museum for visitors to experience the

ambience of a village house. It was built in 1920 by Tuan Haji Hashim bin Dato' Demang Haji Abdul Ghani, a pioneer of the Kampung Morten. The house is filled with the essentials and collectibles of the owners.

Sri Poyyatha Vinayagar Moorthi Temple

Being the oldest Hindu Temple in Malaysia, Sri Poyyatha Vinayagar Moorthi Temple is dedicated to Lord Vinayagar or Ganesha, the deity revered for his wisdom and ability to remove obstacles so one could accomplish one's

desire or goal. It is interesting to note the Dutch influence in the architecture of the temple and this can be seen in the details and finishing of the entrance, walls, columns, vaulted domes and roof tiling.



Hang Tuah Mausoleum

The Hang Tuah Mausoleum is located about 15 kilometers from Melaka town in Tanjung Kling. Hang Tuah is a famous Malay warrior who is brave and good in martial arts. He is the youngest knight appointed

in Melaka. It was referred to as the old tomb so that it will not be seized and destroyed by the Portuguese and its invaders.

Malaysia Prison Museum

The Malaysia Prison Museum was the 2nd prison in Malaysia and formerly known as H.M.Jail. This prison was built in 1860 by Gabenor Kolonel Cavenagh and provided about 48 exhibitions comprising of all prisons in Malaysia. In this prison, the visitors will be guided by prison officers/warders. The other attractions are exhibition of execution of death penalty / prisoner's

cell, motivational talk, canning demonstration, the sleep over at museum package, pocket show, notes from jail and others.

Cheng Hoon Teng Temple



Cheng Hoon Teng temple, or known as the Green Clouds Temple, located at Jalan Tokong or Harmonious Street, near Jonker Street. Colourful stalls clustered around the entrance of the temple selling candles, josspaper

and aromatic joss-sticks required by devotees. In the temple you will see devotees performing prayer rites that have been handed down from generation to generation, since the Chinese first settled in Melaka.

Culture

Throughout the passage of time, Melaka's socio-culture has blossomed with diversity, continuity, nationalism, racial integration and subliminal harmony. Melaka today is a glorious cosmopolitan steeped in rich culture and tradition.



Malay Community

Majority of Melaka people's are Malays and they usually live in villages as tight knit communities.

They speak Malay, practice Islam and bear Arabic names and are steeped with traditions.



Chinese Community



The second largest community is the Chinese. Synonymous with business and entrepreneurship, the

Chinese are usually predominant in the cities. Despite passage of time and process this race comprising of the various dialect groups such as Hokkien, Cantonese, Hakka, Teochew and Hainanese retain their legacies and still practice their various traditional festivities and religious rites.

Indian Community

The Indian community make up another important ethnic group Melaka. Deepavali is the main celebration of the Hindu Indians and

Thaipusam being their religious event with several rituals including a procession from one temple to another.



Baba Nyonya Community

Melaka is also where the Babas and Nyonyas or Peranakans originate. They are descendants of the Chinese who arrived in Melaka and married

locals. They retain many Chinese customs but Malay is their mother-tongue. They have adopted the Malay-style of dressing.



Portuguese Community

During the Portuguese rule, many of them choose to remain in Melaka and since 1920, preferred to live in the Portuguese Settlement. They speak an ancient Portuguese Dialect called *Cristo*. They still practice their age old festivals and customs. Besides Christmas they also celebrate the San Pedro in commemoration

of their patron saint – St Pedro – every 29th June and it is a very colourful affair.



Chitty Community

The Melakan Chittys are Straits-born Indian and offsprings of Indian traders who came from Panai Koromandel in India. This

unique community is the descendants of the early Indian merchant who came here sometime during the 15th century. They practice Hindu faith, speaks Malay, food is typical Indian and they practice the traditional Indian wedding ceremony. The Chitty women wears 'sarung' just like the Nyonyas and traditional Malay women.



Tranquerah Mosque

Built in 1728, Tranquerah Mosque is one of the oldest mosques in the country. Located in Melaka Tengah, the mosque was the State Mosque before Masjid Al-Azim was built. The original mosque structure was made entirely of timber brought in from Kalimantan, Indonesia. It had since

undergone several renovations and restorations. It has been gazette under the National Heritage Act 2005.



Chitty Museum

The location of the Chitty Museum within the Chitty Settlement in Gajah Berang, Melaka is very strategic in attracting more tourists into the Melaka state. The museum exhibits the culture and customs in the daily life of the Chitty community. Information about the history and chronology of this community can be also found here. Tools and accessories such as in religious, wedding ceremonies, cooking and

costumes are the main attractions in this museum dedicated to this small but resilient minority community in the state.

Jonker Walk

Jonker Walk is well known for its art galleries, antique shops, among them goldsmiths, watch repairers, clog makers and beaded shoemakers, food outlets and many more. It is truly a place where the culture and traditions of Melaka seem to seep from every nook and cranny of the quaint little shops which line this street. The street becomes a



flea market for antique lovers every Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 6pm to midnight.

Hang Tuah Centre

A reference centre that displays Hang Tuah's superiority as an admirable figure. Hang Tuah's journeys of life from his childhood until adolescence were based on Malay history and Hikayat Hang Tuah. Interaction and modeling techniques will definitely make your visit more interesting. This complex also contains a mini auditorium that can be used for theater, film and video for screening, cultural performance, seminars also others. It contains five houses which represent the Malay warriors which are Hang Tuah, Hang Jebat, Hang

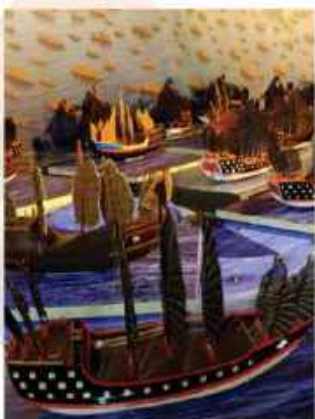

Cheng Ho Cultural Museum

Cheng Ho Cultural Museum is believed to be a restructured ancient building with Ming architecture, with two to three hundred years of history. The famous Cheng Ho is the Ming Dynasty Admiral who has visited Malacca many times while en route to the Western Ocean from 1405-1433. It is believed that he has set up a huge warehouse complex along the northern side of Malacca River. To date, there has been dispute in the location of the warehouse



complex, while some are believed to be at Bukit Cina. Nevertheless, the museum showcases many evidences of cultural exchange between the local ethnic and the Chinese, among others, treasure ships, tea houses and other navigation instruments.

Desa Paku House & Garden

Desa Paku House and Garden is about 22km from Melaka town, in rural Alor Gajah. From the Alor Gajah toll, go into town, take the roundabout at 12 o'clock before slowing down at the Alor Gajah or Masjid Tanah junction then turn right. After a kilometre or so, look out for the signboard kampung Baru. Drive in about 600 metres and turn left into a gate, drive through and take the first turn right. Visits are by appointment only. Reconfirmation required 48 hours before date of



visit. A traditional Malay Melaka-style houses set in a delightful four-acre garden with a collection of up to 200 species of heliconias and their related plants, an amazing array of palms and six freshwater fishponds.



Soon Lee Bee Farm

Soon Lee Bee Farm is located 2km from the Ayer Keroh Toll Plaza off the North-South Expressway, about 15km from Melaka town. The Soon Lee Bee Farm allows visitors to study how they rear bees and extract from the hives for commercial purposes. The farm has been very successful in apiculture, which is the scientific term for bee farming. Visitors can consult experts at the farm to understand any aspect of apicultural techniques such as the breeding of bees, the management of hives and pest control.

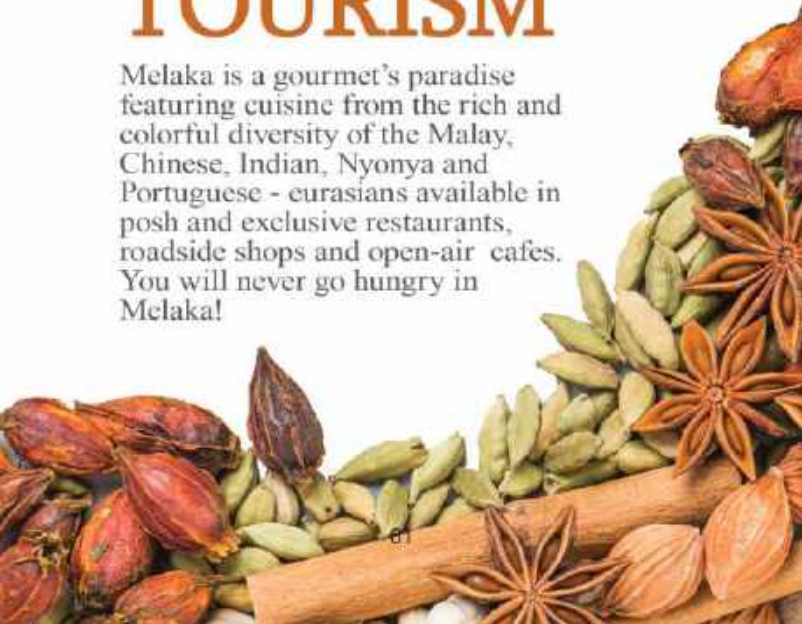

Cencaluk



Cencaluk is a Melakan food made of fermented small shrimps. It is usually served as a condiment together with chillis, shallots and lime juice.

Belacan

Belacan, a Malay variety of shrimp paste, is prepared from fresh tiny shrimp of a species known as 'geragau' in Malay. They are mashed into a paste and buried for several months. The fermented shrimp are then dug up, fried and hard-pressed into cakes.



Belacan is used as an ingredient in many dishes, or eaten on its own with rice. A common preparation is sambal belacan, made by mixing belacan with chilli peppers, minced garlic, shallot paste and sugar and then fried.

Cendol

A scrumptious dessert of green bean noodles flavoured with pandan juice (screwpine leaves) and served with shaved ice, thick palm sugar syrup and 'santan' (coconut milk). It's one of Melaka's best loved desserts, what more on a hot day.

Eidul – Adha

Eidul al-Adha is celebrated on the tenth day of the month of Zulhijjah. A Muslim is urged to make sacrifices – slaughtering or korban – and distribute the korban to the needy.



Maulidur Rasul

Maulidur Rasul commemorates the Islamic Prophet Muhammad SAW's birthday on the 12th day of the third month according to the Islamic calendar.



Chinese New Year



Chinese New Year is the first day of the Chinese lunar calendar's new year; the festivities span 15 days with fireworks,

lion dances, and open houses with scrumptious Chinese cuisine that no one would want to miss!

Wesak Day Celebration & Procession



Wesak Day is celebrated on the day of the first full moon of the ancient lunar month of Vesakha, which usually falls between mid-May and June. It is a time for religious

gatherings, making offerings and donations, meditating and observing the teachings of Lord Buddha as a righteous way to lead life.

Chap Goh Mei

Chap Goh Mei, also known as Lantern Festival, is held on the fifteenth night of the Chinese New Year to mark the festival's finale. Lion dances, lantern decorations, and firecrackers are just a few of the Chap Goh Mei entertainment.



Moon Cake Festival



Moon Cake Festival or called Mid – Autumn Festival is celebrated on the fifteenth day of the 8th month of the Chinese Lunar Calendar and symbolised the family reunion. Moon cakes are served as a symbol of reunion and happiness.

Fiesta Intrudu

Intrudu is a Portuguese festival, celebrated by Portuguese people worldwide, to mark the beginning of the 40-day Lent period, a time of prayer and fasting which covers Maundy Thursday (Last Supper of Jesus Christ), Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday to remember Christ's death.

The celebration is observed on the Sunday before Ash Wednesday and it marks the last day of enjoyment before the start of the Lent period. This centuries-old celebration is unique to the 1,200 strong



Portuguese-Eurasian community here in Melaka as it is the only Portuguese village in Malaysia.



Ponggal

Ponggal or Thai Ponggal is a harvest festival celebrated in January and February to express gratitude to 'Lord Indra' for blessing the farmers

to yield a bountiful harvest. Ponggal, a combination of boiled rice and coconut, is presented to the Sun God as a sign of gratitude.

Thaipusam

Thaipusam is celebrated on the full moon of the Tamil month of Thai (January – February). It is a festival devoted to Lord Murugan and is the ideal time for Hindu devotees to repent at the temple.



Masi Magam Celebration

Masi Magam is a celebration celebrated in the Tamil month of Masi, which spans from February to March. Masi Magam is celebrated once a year as a sign of ancestral blessings and good health.



Deepavali

Deepavali or Diwali is a Hindu festival of lights celebrated annually between October and November. It is a five-day festival that features scrumptious cuisine, fireworks, and colourful rice sand known as 'Kolam'.



Datuk Chacar Festival

The Datuk Chacar Festival is celebrated to commemorate gratitude. It was the ideal time for believers to pray for protection against smallpox and as a cleansing ritual.



Christmas

Celebrating Christmas at the Portuguese Settlement on Christmas Day would provide tourists visiting Melaka with an unforgettable experience. All of the houses and streets in the village are magnificently decorated with light displays, creating a one-of-a-kind

panorama that cannot be seen anywhere else in the country.



San Pedro Fiesta

It is the most prominent cultural festival of the Melaka Portuguese population, particularly those residing in the Portuguese settlement. The San Pedro Festival, also known as the Feast of St. Peter, is held in honour of the patron saint of fishermen. The annual celebration will undoubtedly become more vibrant with a cultural performance by the Melaka Portuguese. Local Portuguese gastronomy will be sought after during this event, as it is likely to be served exclusively for special ceremonies like this. The fishing boat competition is the event's highlight, and the local community eagerly anticipates it as the



owners of the best-decorated boats are awarded handsomely. Thousands of visitors flock to the Portuguese Settlement to mingle and celebrate it with the locals during this festival.

Good Friday

Good Friday marks a sorrowful day in the Christian calendar, commemorating the death and crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Good Friday is celebrated at the oldest surviving church in the country, keeping with centuries-old Portuguese traditions. The following Sunday after Good Friday is Easter Sunday. Christians in Melaka, like Christians all around the globe, commemorate Holy Easter Sunday, the resurrection of Jesus Christ.



Vaisakhi

Vaisakhi marks the beginning of the solar New Year and is a religious festival in Sikhism as it marks the birth of Khalsa (Sikh religion). It is celebrated on the 13th of April every year and it marks the first day of the month of Vaisakh. On this



day, Sikhs got to the Gurdwara to pray and religious services are held.

Sant Baba Sohan Singh Ji Yadghar Semagam

Sant Baba Sohan Singh Ji's Yadghar Semagam is a religious event celebrated annually in remembrance of Sant Baba Sohan Singh



Ji who was a highly respected Sikh priest who resided in Melaka. He was the most venerated and revered Sikh religious personality in Malaysia. Even after his demise, multitudes of followers who gather from far and near come to attend the annual commemorative prayers, held in his memory, without fail in May.

This visionary city of international multiracialism will be the centre of youth development and progress.

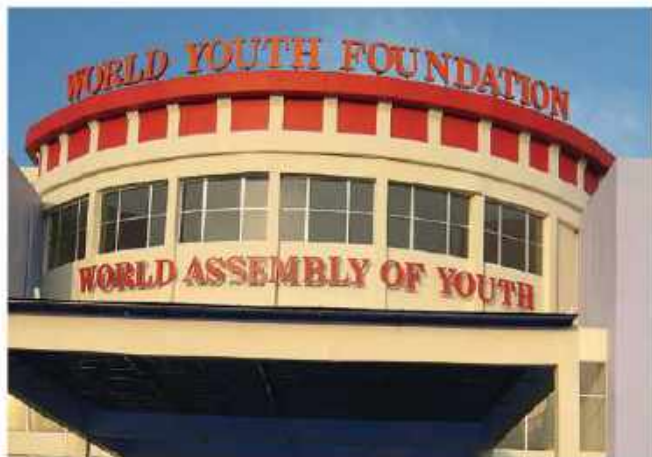
