PRE REGISTRATION

The Academic Unit will ensure that all students from the affected countries are well-informed regarding the preventive plans outlined via e-mails & phone calls before travelling to Malaysia.

- L. Students should TRAVEL ALONE without family members until their home country is free from nCoV outbreak.
- Students with clinical symptoms suggesting nCoV should POSTPONE their travel to Malaysia until certified healthy and free of nCoV by their health authorities.

REGISTRATION

Upon arrival in Malaysia, all international students arriving from the affected countries must report themselves to The University Health Centre.

Health Declaration Form

The form will be submitted to the University Health Centre for reference. **Returning students** who are registering for their new semester should declare their **health status** and **travel history** during their recent semester break. Those with **recent travel history** (less than 14 days) to the countries involved should report themselves to the University Health Centre.

Red Alert Card.

The card will be issued to the students upon reporting to University Health Centre.

If they develop any fever > 38 degrees Celcius, pneumonia or severe respiratory infection with breathlessness within the self-monitoring period, the University Health Centre should be informed.

Medical evaluation by the **University Health Centre** team with infection control precautions as per guidelines.
