COVID-19: REVISED DATES FOR 2019-2020 ACADEMIC SESSION AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ONLINE TEACHING AND LEARNING

With reference to the above matter.

2. In line with the Vice Chancellor Memorandum No. 1/2020 dated 27th of March 2020 and the Memorandum from the Department of Registrar No. 13/2020 dated 27th March 2020, I hereby confirm that the revised dates for academic session 2019-2020 are as follows:

3. All Faculties/Institutes/Centres are to conduct courses **fully** online until further notice. For any course that requires evaluation through a final examination, the examination shall be conducted through the open book examination method which can be conducted either as an online exam or the conventional method (with safety restrictions, if the situation allows).
