VISA APPROVAL LETTER (VAL) AND STUDENT PASS ISSUANCE

- 3. The VAL application process will take a minimum of 14 working days from date of complete application and payment (not inclusive of UKMSHAPE internal process. Once your documents are accepted, you may start tracking your application on the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) website at https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/. All approved VAL applications will be issued with an Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL), which you can download from the website once it is approved. Please note that since the VAL is issued by the Immigration Department, the processing time is subject to their discretion. UKMSHAPE has no authority or influence over this process.
- 4. The requirement to leave the country depends on the type of pass you hold at the time of application, as well as the type of institution you are transferring to or from. Please be reminded that UKMSHAPE will only accept passport submissions once you are registered as a student. Therefore, if you have shortened your previous Student Pass from your previous institution, please ensure that you have a sufficient period to remain in Malaysia until the date of registration. In the event that you do not have a valid pass during this transition period, you are required to return to your home country and apply for a new VAL under "New" category.
- 5. International students are allowed to enter Malaysia only after their eVAL/SEV is approved, provided it is still within the registration period. You may schedule your travel date after receiving your eVAL/SEV (the earliest flight date is 7 days before physical registration / reporting date). Therefore, if you are required to leave the country and return to Malaysia using a Single Entry Visa (SEV), please present your eVAL at the immigration checkpoint. A special pass will be stamped in your passport to grant you a valid stay while you process your student pass. The validity of this special pass can range between 14 to 30 days, at the discretion of the Immigration Department. Upon arrival in Malaysia, it is important that you undergo a post-arrival medical screening at the UKM Health Centre within 7 working days from your entry date and submit the report together with your passport after you have completed your registration in UKMSHAPE. As of the publication date of this document, the cost of the medical screening is RM250 and shall be borne by the student. Please be reminded that failure to adhere to this timeframe may result in rejection of student pass sticker issuance.

RENEWALS AND STUDENT PASS CANCELLATION

6. Student Pass renewal

A student pass allows multiple entries and normally has a one (1) year validity. It is issued on an annual basis and EMGS renewal fees are to be paid by students. **Renewal should be made as early as 3 months or at least 2 months before student pass expiry date.** If your pass duration is valid for more than 1 year (or for one-off passes), it is compulsory for you to submit your academic transcript and attendance for your **iKad** and **insurance** renewal every year.

7. Cancellation of student pass

If a student's status matches any of the following conditions, they are required to cancel/shorten their student pass by applying for a Check out Memo (COM) before leaving Malaysia:

- Completion of studies and status have changed in UKM system (no longer active and registered)
- Deferment of studies (to resume studies, student must apply for a new VAL application)
- Withdrawn from University
- Dismissed from University
- Student pass / iKad renewal rejected by Immigration Department
- Inactive / not registered in current semester (MIA)
- Intend to return to the home country earlier than the completion date stated in the Confirmation Letter (e.g. waiting for Senate Approval, to complete studies while in the home country (internship / online VIVA) etc.)

Please note that leaving Malaysia without proper cancellation (COM) is an Immigration offence and may cause your Personal Bond to be forfeited. Therefore, students are required to apply for the COM within 2 weeks from date of completion status / deferment approval / release / dismissal letter by submitting their passport, flight ticket to home country and other related documents. In the event that a student failed to report to UKMSHAPE by the end of the second week, UKMSHAPE reserves the right to proceed with a forced cancellation by lodging a police report and submitting the cancellation to EMGS/Immigration, and the personal bond will be forfeited. Any forced cancellation will cause the student to be blacklisted by Immigration.

8. Please be reminded that all international students are required to comply with the rules and guidelines set by the Malaysian authorities at all times while in Malaysia. PERSONAL BOND REQUIREMENTS

The Immigration Department requires all education institutions in Malaysia to sign a personal bond on behalf of the candidate, binding the University for a specified sum. To comply with this requirement, the institution will require you to lodge the specified amount for this purpose. This money will be returned to you upon completion or withdrawal of your study in the institution, on condition that there is no violation of any provision of the Immigration laws of Malaysia.
